They faced Tahoma - the #1 ranked team, and who ended up winning it all - in their first game on Friday. They battled hard and took a set off of them, but lost 1-3 (18-25, 25-20, 18-25, 9-25). Later Friday evening, they faced West Valley and their boisterous home crowd, but flew by them, winning 3-1 (20-25, 25-14, 25-15, 25-19). In their third game on Saturday, they battled hard against Richland (who finished 2nd in state last year), but came up a bit short, losing a hard-fought game 1-3 (17-25, 25-19, 23-25, 22-25).
