
EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Wrestling: The wrestling team had a successful dual meet on Thursday defeating Mercer Island 72-12. Gymnastics: The IHS Gymnastics team celebrate their first win of the season over district rival Skyline and Inglemoor High School! The team earned a total of 163.70 points, followed by Inglemoor with 160.40 and Skyline with 137.70. With a total of 7 gymnasts finishing in the top 15, Issaquah had several strong performances, including senior Maya Mandyam who tied for 1st place All-Around and freshman Eloise Mullet with a 3rd place finish on vault. Boys Basketball: Varsity got its first win of the season over Enumclaw on Saturday after a couple tough games vs. Woodinville and Skyline. Saxon Cullimore had a solid week shooting the ball, including a team-high 22 points against the Spartans. The JV team went 1-1 this week: beating Woodinville 70-56 Tuesday night, with a well-balanced effort by Dietiker (18 pts), Longo (13 pts) and Sheffield & Smith (each with 11 pts). JV lost a close one to Skyline Friday. The C team remains undefeated after a great week of wins over Woodinville 60-40 and Skyline47-41. Leading the way was Kautzsch (29 pts this week), Stroh (25 pts) & Kodosky (21 pts). A highlight of the Woodinville game was Finn Kronstad's 4-point play late in the 4th quarter.
