EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Boys SWIVE - On Tuesday, the Issaquah lost to the 3A Powerhouse, Mercer Island, by the score of 102-84. Despite the outcome, there were several highlights. Sophomore diver **Robert Gref** remains undefeated. The Medley Relay team of **Weston Crewe, Owen Zablocki, Chris Harig and Chris Leu** qualified for the state championship meet. **Chris Harig** also qualified individually in the 100 Fly. On Saturday, 22 members of the team represented Issaquah at the Kentridge Invitational and finished in 3rd PLACE out of 43 teams. Way to go boys! All three relays qualified for February's state championship with fast swims by **Ryan Cho, Weston Crewe, Jack Githens, Adam Hansen, Chris Harig, Chris Leu, Karl Yount and Owen Zablocki**. Individual event point scorers were: Crewe - 100 Back (3rd PI) and 100 Fly (6th) – qualifying for state in both events; Robert Gref – Diving (3rd); Hansen – 500 Free (14th); Harig – 200 IM (4th – state qualifying) and 100 Breast (7th); Tyler Ko – 100 Back (20th); Chris Leu – 100 Fly (17th); Luca Pungan – 100 Breast (8th) and 200 IM (13th); Josh Sun – 100 Back (14th); Karl Yount – 50 Free (13th) and 100 Free (11th); Owen Zablocki – 200 IM (14th) and 100 Breast (15th). Cameron Aaselund, Kyle Lee and Tuan Zhang also contributed with great relay performances. To date, 39 team members have qualified for KingCo champs, 23 for District Champs (see team website for full list of qualifiers). Way to go Eagles! Next up: Issaquah hosts Interlake on Tuesday 1/14 at 4:00pm at Boehm pool.



Wrestling - The wrestling team continued its winning ways defeating Redmond 48-29, Bellevue 76-0 and Sammamish 69-6 to remain in 1st place and undefeated in Kingco at 9-0. All 14 varsity wrestlers won at least 1 match via pin, pulling out a pin in all 3 matches were **Zach Mayes, Carson Tanner, Nathan Asistin, and Victor Marcenac**. Last weekend at the Everett Classic tournament the following took home hardware in their weight classes: **3rd Brady Malone, Victor Marcenac, 5th Cory Kawaguchi, Declan Treacy**. In the JV tournament the following medaled: **1st Jacob Law, Mason Stewart, 2nd Nick Hunter, Zac McKee, 5th Grant Strassel**. Congratulations to **Carson Tanner** for taking 4th place in the 132 lb. weight class at the Gut Check Wrestling Tournament Jan. 3rd and 4th at the Showare Center in Kent, WA. Gut Check is one of the toughest tournaments on the West Coast. Top wrestlers and teams from six states and Canada are invited to compete in the tournament including Blair Academy, the #1 high school wrestling team in the country. There were 41 other wrestlers in Carson's bracket and the top eight place. IHS wrestler **Nathan Asistin** also competed at Gut Check.

Gymnasatics - Led by senior **Maya Mandyam** placing 1st and freshman **Eloise Mullet** finishing in 3rd in the All-Around, the gymnastics team had another strong showing against Eastlake and Woodinville High Schools on January 9. The team finished a very close 2nd place behind perennial favorite Woodinville, with a season high total of 171.70 points. On vault, senior **Stephanie Callans** finished in 2nd and **Isobel Grudin** was only .10 behind in 3rd place! Maya placed 1st on balance beam with a season high score of 9.7, and **Hannah Powell** had a great routine finishing in 5th place on uneven bars. **Thank you to our IHS JV & Varsity Cheerleaders for coming out to support and help score this event! Girls Basketball – The Varsity girls crushed Mt. Si by 38 points on Wednesday. A combination of solid defense and great shooting put the game out of reach early. **Keira Hanson** finished with 18 points, and **Lauren Frueh** almost registered a double-double with 10 points and 8 rebounds. They followed up that victory with another one against Bothell (63-42). **Alivia Stephens** had a game-high 20 pints and four girls scored 9 points each: **Cam Gibson, Keira Slippern, Shea Dillon, and Lauren Frueh**. The team also took three charges (**Hannah Cameron, Keira Hanson, Lauren Frueh**). With their fourth win in a row, the girls moved to 10-3 overall, 6-1 in KingCo, and remain in first place in the Crest Division.

Unfortunately, Bothell won the game with a buzzer-beater.

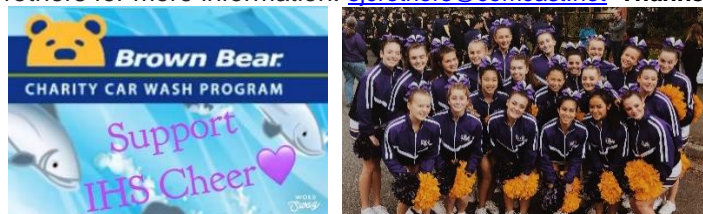
