EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

DECA - This year, we had 197 compete at the Area Competition. Those students competed in a variety of events, but mostly they reviewed business case studies, and then gave impromptu presentations of their solutions. At events this year, 83 students earned Finalists awards, which means they got a top 10 score in one category. That is the highest number of Finalists we have EVER had. 45 students also qualified for State in their events, which means they were the top-9 overall. In addition, 18 students ended up in the top 3 of their event! **Ishaan Sharma** received 1st place in the Entrepreneurship Series Event. **Clara Wolff** and **Nicole Lee** (1st year DECA students) received 1st place in Marketing Management Team Decision Making Event. We are so proud of all of our students & couldn't have done it without tremendous support of the teacher chaperones and 35 parent volunteers!



Dance - IHS Dance Team placed 2nd in the Hip Hop, 3rd in Dance and 3rd in Pom at the WIAA Redmond Dance/Drill Competition this weekend. The team received qualifying scores advancing them to Districts in March for all styles!



Performing Arts - In 2015-2016 Evergreen Philharmonic played a pair of concerts where we played the music from a popular on-line video game called Guild Wars 2. The composer was there, and the events were videoed an uploaded to YouTube. *We just were informed that the number of views of that video has surpassed 200K!*

Girls Basketball – The Varsity Girls finished up a season sweep of KingCo 2A/3A teams with a 64-34 win over Juanita on Saturday. **Alivia Stephens** led the way with 24 points. **Katie MacNary** scored 11 and had multiple steals, blocks, and rebounds. **Shea Dillon** knocked down three threes for the second game in a row. **Mercedes Tinder** returned to action after several games (recovering from an injury) and immediately made an impact on the boards, and freshman **Hannah Cameron** continued her varsity development scoring four points and grabbing several rebounds. The team is now 11-3 overall and remains in first place in the Crest Division (6-1). The girls are currently ranked #10 in the state RPI calculations. On Friday, the <u>JV Girls</u> lost a tough close game to the undefeated Rogers H.S. team. On Saturday, the girls were back to their winning ways with a 47-11 win over Juanita. Every player scored at least 2 points with **Azra Sunderland** leading the night with 13 and **Courtney Smith** with 10. **Julia Wood** led the team with 8 rebounds and 7 steals. The JV girls are now 11-3 overall. The <u>Girls C-Team</u> took on Rogers in Puyallup this week and they proved to be the strongest competition they have seen this season. They played strong as a team and extended their undefeated streak to 6-0 with the win over Rogers 33-31.



Boys Basketball –The Boys Varsity basketball team emerged from the snow storms with a needed road win at North Creek. Playing a makeup game on Thursday night, **Charlie Dietiker** scored 19 points, **Timmy Crandall** had 16 (including a go-ahed three pointer with :28 left), and **Saxon Cullimore** knocked down four key freethrows down the stretch. The boys continue their pursuit of the playoffs by staying a game ahead of Newport in the Crest Division. <u>JV Boys</u> fell to 6-6 on the year, as they dropped a game on Tuesday to North Creek 57-44. <u>C-Team Boys</u> improved to 8-1 on the season after defeating Skyline on Thursday 53-37. They take on undefeated North Creek on Monday at 7pm.



Wrestling - Another exciting week for the wrestling team as we celebrated our **6 graduating seniors** Nathan Asistin, Brennen Lee, Kyle Huard, Cory Kawaguchi, Grant Strassel and Carson Tanner. The team produced 2 victories against Lake Washington 64-18 and 54-12 to remain undefeated and in 1st place in Kingco. Wrestlers who went undefeated on the night: **Grant Strassel, Victor Marcenac, Alex Witecki, Nick Hunter, Zach Fortes, Brennen Lee, Brady Malone, Cory Kawaguchi, Nathan Asistin and Carson Tanner**. On Saturday, the Eagles took 1st place in the *End of Days* tournament at Lakes High School. Lead by 6 wrestlers who qualified for the championship in their weight class. Taking 2nd were **Zach Fortes, Nathan Asistin, Declan Treacy, Victor Marcenac, and Cory Kawaguchi**. 3rd place finishers were **Nick Hunter, Alex Witecki, and Richard Martin**. Taking 5th was **Zach Mayes**. Continuing with his stellar season **Carson Tanner** took 1st in his 138 pound weight class and was named wrestler of the meet. Congratulations to the Eagles wrestling team and our outstanding seniors!
