EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

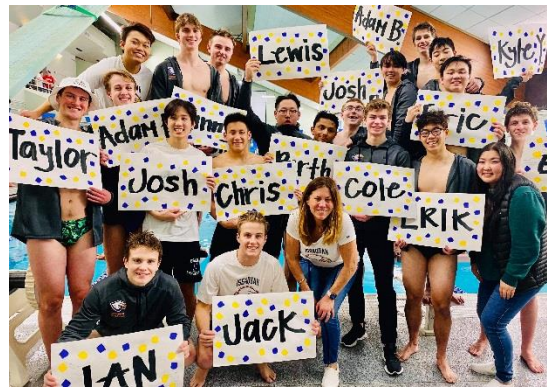

The competition was at Ingraham High School and there were over 100 students in attendance from various schools. 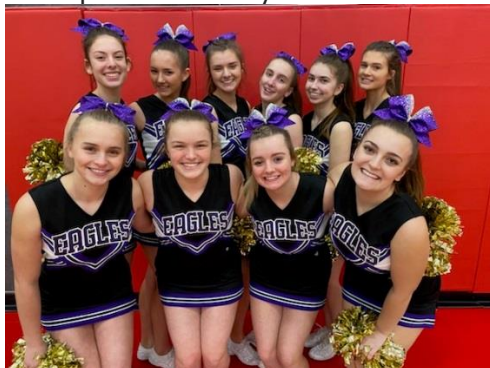

Boys Basketball – Varsity fell short to both Eastlake (62-43) & top-ranked Mount Si (56-71) this week. *no official report for Varsity. JV won both games this week and are now 10-6 for the year. On Tuesday, they knocked off Eastlake 65-59 in overtime. **Chase Dietiker** poured in 29 points and **Tate Smith** added 14. Issaquah got some revenge from a loss earlier in the year to Mt. Si by pulling away in the 4th quarter on Saturday night for a 70-55 win. **Chase Dietiker** had 18 points and **Andrew Mattson** scored 14 to lead the way. Boys C-Team improved their record to 11-1 (8-0 in conference) with two more wins this week.
