EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Girls Basketball – Varsity: After capturing 1st place in the Crest Division with a 10-3 KingCo record, the girls lost two nail-biter, league playoff games in the final seconds -- to Inglemoor and then Eastlake -- despite strong performances from 1st Team All-KingCo selection **Alivia Stephens** and 2nd-teamer **Keira Hanson**. The season continues Friday at 7pm as the girls play a home game against WesCo's #5 seed (either Mount Vernon or Monroe). **Camryn Gibson** and **Katie MacNary** also earned Honorable Mention All-KingCo this season, and the team looks to move forward from its tough losses en route to a berth at state. JV: The girls won their final game of the year vs. Redmond 50-33 to finish the season 16-3 and undefeated in KingCo. They were led by **Paka Ferrer** and **Avery Knirk** with 11 points each followed by **Azra Sunderland** with 9. Now they'll cheer on the varsity team as they make a push for State! Go Eagles!

C-Team: The Girls pulled out an **undefeated season** (11-0) with a big win of 78-13 over Interlake this week. **Grace McKillop** led the Eagles with 31pts and 17 rebounds, **Emma Snyder** had 21pts and 11 rebounds and **Tara Furukawa** with 18pts and 4 rebounds. Great season ladies!



Boys Basketball – Varsity: A challenging season ended with a tough loss at the buzzer to Woodinville. The good news is three juniors earned All-KingCo recognition. **Charlie Dietiker** was named 2nd Team, and **Danny Howe** and **Timmy Crandall** were both honorable mention. Season highlights included a 33 point performance from **Charlie**, a 34 point outing from **Danny**, and a great senior night win where **Tommy Reisner**, **Coben Kaveny**, **Saxon Cullimore**, and **Rowan Dillon** all contributed and the crowd went wild for **Adam Liske**. 2020-2021 should be a good one for boys hoops at IHS. JV: The boys beat Redmond 49-48 on Tuesday night, ending the season on a 5-game winning streak to finish at 11-6. **Mason Muir** and **Tate Smith** each had 12 points to lead the scoring. C-Team: It was raining 3's on Monday as the C team took down Eastlake 65-38, scoring 39 points from beyond the arc. **Joe Roche** lead the charge with 9 points. On Thursday, they suffered their second loss of the season falling to Mount Si 46-49. **Wyatt Dow** (8 pts) and **Jack Kautzch** (9 pts) had outstanding defensive efforts on the boards while **William Kodosky** took it to them on offense racking up 18 points. C-Team finishes their season this week with games on Monday at Redmond and home on Tuesday vs. Bothell.

Gymnastics - Gymnastics had a great meet at Districts on Saturday, placing 3rd behind Woodinville and Northcreek, narrowly missing making State as a team by one place. Several personal bests were achieved, and 6 girls qualified for state. **Steph Callans** qualified on Floor, **Maya Mandyam** qualified for All-Around, **Skye Barlow** will compete Vault, **Vanessa Sebring** qualified for Balance Beam, **Eloise Mullett** will compete on Beam, Floor and Bars, and **Tasha Lee** qualified for Floor.
