Scholarships valued at **\$1,000 or greater** will be awarded to selected IHS graduating seniors. Scholarships will be applied to school tuition, fees, and costs. Scholarships must be used during the school year following high school graduation. **Eligibility:** Candidates must be a senior at Issaquah High School, plan to attend any accredited 2 or 4-year university, college, community college, or vocational/technical institute beginning in the fall of the student's graduating year, participate in an IHS Booster Club affiliated co-curricular activity and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. **Criteria for Selection:** In awarding scholarships, the Issaquah High School Booster Club shall evaluate the candidates based on the following: Character, integrity, and personal qualities, a well-balanced high school experience and have meaningful participation in an activity outside of school (work, community service, volunteer, etc.) **Timeline:** The application window is open through May 15, 3pm.
