

EAGLE TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Girl's Basketball – The girls basketball team finished off a fantastic season on Saturday morning, beating Todd Beamer 67-56 to earn a *4th Place in State Trophy*! Overall, the girls had a 22-10 record and won SIX loser-out games on the way to their final game. They went 3-1 at the Tacoma Dome this week, taking down the #2, #5, and #9 teams in the state. The program's overall record for 2019-2020 was 49-13 (the C team finished 11-0 and JV checked-in at 16-3). It was the first trip to State for the girls since 2010, the first 20-win season since 2009, and tied for the second best finish in school history. The team will miss it's beloved seniors **Katie MacNary, Lauren Frueh, and Katie Kellum** and look forward to more success in the coming years returning All-KingCo standouts **Alivia Stephens, Keira Hanson, and Cam Gibson**, along with key players **Mercedes Tinder, Shea Dillon, and Erin Schobbe** and a ton of young talent in the sophomore and freshmen classes. Robotics – The Issaquah Robotics Society participated in our first competition of 2020 at Glacier Peak HS in Snohomish last weekend, on February 29 & March 1st. Overall they were pleased with our competition performance. Their drive team's and robot's performance improved steadily throughout the event and was recognized with the Gracious Professionalism award. Issaquah ranked 10th out of 37 teams following qualification matches. They formed a playoff alliance with the Circuit Breakers form Medical Lake HS and the Sushi Squad from Redmond & won the quarterfinals matches to the alliance that went on to win the competition: Henry M. Jackson HS of Mill Creek, King's HS of Seattle, and Mt. Vernon HS. IHS currently ranks 20th of the 94 teams in the Pacific Northwest district that have competed so far. Unfortunately the remainder of their competition season is uncertain due to the situation with Covid-19. Although they're all disappointed, the students understand that these precautions are necessary and their coaches are proud of how maturely they are handling the situation.
