
Featured Player of the Week Boys Lacrosse: Brian Castro

Issaquah Robotics is excited to announce that we are one of nine robotics teams in the Pacific Northwest to be recognized with a Chairman's Award for the 2020 season. The Chairman's Award is the most prestigious award in robotics and it recognizes teams that best represent a model for other teams to emulate. This award is based on performance over several years and we received it largely due to the thousands of volunteer hours that our student's dedicated to supporting STEM programs for elementary and middle school students, as well as our outreach activities at Salmon Days and other local festivals. Chairman's Awards are normally presented at local robotics competitions, but due to social distancing, this year's awards were presented Friday afternoon during an internet telecast.
