

## Issaquah High School Booster Club Scholarship Program Guidelines Spring 2024

Applications must be received by **3pm on APRIL 28, 2024**No late applications will be accepted.

#### 1. Sponsorship

The scholarship program is sponsored by the Issaquah High School Booster Club. Funds are generated from the contributions of our members and Booster Club fund-raising activities that take place during the year.

#### 2. Eligibility

A candidate must meet each of the following conditions:

- a. Be a senior at Issaguah High School.
- b. Plan to attend any accredited 2- or 4-year university, college, community college, or vocational/technical institute beginning in the fall of the student's graduating year.
- c. Participate in an IHS Booster Club affiliated co-curricular activity.

#### 3. Scholarship awards

Scholarships valued at **\$1,000** or **greater** will be awarded to selected IHS graduating seniors. Scholarships will be applied towards school tuition, fees, and costs. Scholarships must be used during the school year following high school graduation. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution upon the award recipient's submission of a statement to the Booster Club Treasurer.

#### 4. Criteria for Selection

In awarding scholarships, the Issaquah High School Booster Club shall evaluate the candidates based on the following criteria:

- a. Character, integrity, and personal qualities.
- b. Embody a well-balanced high school experience.
- c. Academic achievement.
- d. Additional, meaningful participation in an activity outside of school (work, community service, volunteer, etc.)

## 5. Application must include the following:

- a. Completion of the attached application form
- b. Essay, see prompt on application form, maximum 500 words
- c. High school transcript through the first semester of the applicant's senior year.
- d. High school resume
- e. One letter of recommendation from an adult (not a relative or current IHS student) who has been a witness to your participation in an Issaquah High School Booster Club activity and can speak to your character, integrity and personal qualities.

## 6. Submittal of applications

- a. Applications must be received no later than 3pm on April 28, 2024.
  - i. Applications must be submitted in one single file, electronically (PDF) to StudentAwards.ihsboosters@gmail.com
  - ii. No late applications will be accepted.
- b. Questions can be addressed to Booster Club StudentAwards.ihsboosters@gmail.com
- c. Interviews, if determined by the committee to be necessary, will be held prior to: May 5th.
- d. Scholarships will be presented at the IHS Senior Honors and Awards Program in June.
