Scholarship Program Application Guidelines 2026

Applications must be received by **9:00pm on APRIL 20, 2026**
No late applications will be accepted

1. Sponsorship

The scholarship program is sponsored by the Issaquah High School Booster Club. Funds are generated from the contributions of our members and Booster Club fund-raising activities that take place during the year.

2. Eligibility

A candidate must meet each of the following conditions:

- a. Be a senior at Issaquah High School.
- b. Plan to attend any accredited 2- or 4-year university, college, community college, or vocational/technical institute beginning in the fall of the student's graduating year.
- c. Participate in an IHS Booster Club affiliated co-curricular activity.
- d. Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.

3. Scholarship awards

Scholarships valued at **\$2,000 or greater** will be awarded to selected IHS graduating seniors. Scholarships will be applied towards school tuition, fees, and costs. Scholarships must be used during the school year following high school graduation. Payment will be made by the Booster Club Treasurer directly to the educational institution on behalf of the awarded recipient.

4. Criteria for Selection

In awarding scholarships, the Issaquah High School Booster Club shall evaluate the candidates based on the following criteria:

- a. Character, integrity, and personal qualities.
- b. Embody a well-balanced high school experience.
- c. Academic achievement.
- d. Additional, meaningful participation in an activity outside of school (work, community service, volunteer, etc.)

5. Application must include the following:

1. Completion of the attached application form.
2. High school transcript through the first semester of the applicant's senior year.
3. Academic or College Application Resume
4. Two letters of recommendation:
 - One from the applicant's activity advisor or coach
 - One from an Issaquah High School teacher, community member, employer, etc.

6. Submittal of applications

- a. Applications must be received not later than 5pm on **Monday, April 20, 2025.**
